WOODLAKE HOA POOL RULES Hours: 9am -9 pm

Pool Rules:

- 1. Parent/Guardians are responsible for the actions of their children under age 18 and guest, whether parent is present or not at the pool.
- 2. All swimmers MUST sign the sign-in sheet upon entering the pool complex.
- 3. Children under the age of 5 shall not be in the pool without a parent/guardian (18 or older) immediately present in water.
- 4. Parent/guardian is to remain in the enclosed fence area at all times with their child.
- 5. Children 12 and older do not need to be accompanied by an adult when the lifeguard is on duty.
- 6. Children 14 or younger **MUST** be accompanied by a parent/guardian (18 or older) when there is no Lifeguard on duty.
- 7. Anyone under 17 years old shall **not** swim alone.
- 8. No more than 30 people may be in the pool at a time.
- 9. Swim attire must be worn. Normal attire (cut-offs, running shorts, basketball shorts) is not allowed.
- 10. ALL swimmers age 13 years old and younger must pass the swim proficiency test prior to being allowed in the deep end of the pool.
 - The test is as follows: Beginning at the shallow end, swim (crawl stroke) to the deep end and tread water for 30 seconds, then swim back to the shallow end. At no time will the swimmer be allowed to touch the bottom or sides of the pool. At no time will non-swimmers be allowed beyond the blue line of the pool.
 - Passage of the test is at the discretion of the guard administering the test.

 There is no "appeal" process. At the discretion of the guards on duty, the swimmer may be asked to "retake" the swim test. If for any reason the swimmer does not pass the test, they may retake the test on the next swim day.

11. NO DIVING PERMITTED

HEALTH RULES:

- 1. A CLEANSING SHOWER MUST BE TAKEN IN THE POOL HOUSE PRIOR TO ENTERING THE POOL. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2. Use by anyone who has been ill with vomiting or diarrhea within the last 2 weeks is prohibited
- 3. Use by anyone with a communicable disease is prohibited.
- 4. Anyone with seizures, heart or circulatory problems must not swim alone.
- 5. Children who are not toilet trained must wear tight fitting protective coverings.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Pool Gate must be locked at all times. You must use your key to gain access to the pool. Residents must not open the gate for any resident.
- 2. One key is provided to each homeowner. Replacement key's will be charges \$50 to homeowners.
- 3. **No food** in the pool area. There are tables available for use in the grass area outside the pool. **PLEASE** place all trash in garbage cans located near pool entrance and clean up and spills.
- 4. Beverages (non-alcoholic) are allowed on the pool deck area in non-glass containers.
- 5. Possession and use of alcohol or drugs or smoking is not allowed in any area around the pool facility. This includes Oral use of tobacco, nicotine products, cigarettes, vaping, ecigarettes, nicotine, and nicotine delivery devices.
- 6. Pets are not allowed at the pool facility. This includes the grassy area.

GUESTS OF RESIDENTS:

- 1. **ALL** guests must be accompanied by the adult (18 or older) Homeowner at all times. Residents are responsible for their guest. Not following the rules will result in the guest and resident being asked to leave.
- 2. **RESIDENT OF WOODLAKE HAVE PRIORITY OVER GUESTS.** Number of guests are limited to 4 per household. Larger groups can be accommodated by reserving the pool.

Private Parties:

- 1. The pool may be reserved for 2 hours. The first hour will be private for the party and the second hour residents will be allowed, however party will take priority. The limit of people in the pool is 30 people.
- 2. The fee to reserve the pool will be \$100, payable to the Woodlake HOA. Payment is due to the pool manager at least 7 days prior to event.

HOMEOWNERS/RESIDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. All residents must read and follow all pool rules at all times.
- 2. Homeowners are responsible for the actions of their children and guest. Ensure that the rules are explained and understood by your guests.
- 3. Any resident of Woodlake and the Lifeguard have the authority to remove any person, regardless of age, because of unacceptable behavior.
- 4. The Woodlake Board or Trustees reserves the right to deny pool privileges to any resident who continues to violate the pool rules.
- 5. Contact the Pool Manager or any HOA board member ASAP if there has been an incident in the pool of vomiting or find feces in the pool. All persons in the pool must vacate immediately as this process a serious health threat to all person in the pool.
